 in gold or Silver money at its present weight and value I Do
 give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Catharina Schwellter the
 the Sum of thirty five pounds in gold or Silver money at its present
 weight and value I Do give and Bequeath unto my Son Michael
 Hedlay the Sum of Fifty Pounds in gold or Silver money at its present
 weight and value I Do give and Bequeath to my Daughter
 Christina Ryman the Sum of thirty five pounds in gold or Silver
 money at its present weight and value and whereas my Daughter
 Sarah Henrich has Departed this Life I Do give and Bequeath the
 Sum of Fifteen Pounds in gold or Silver money at its present weight
 and value To be Equally Divided amongst her three children the Heirs
 of her Body Namely Sarah Henrich John Henrich and Catharina
 Henrich I Do give and Shall Bequeath To my Dear and Loving
 Wife Catharina Hedlay During her natural Life the one third part of
 my Personal Estate She Shall have my Store room Together with
 the Stove and privilage to the kitchen and fire place She Shall have
 in the Spring house or cellar She Shall have a Right to one upper
 chimney to put things in I shall have one cow and two sheep
 and they shall find fodder and stable room for them She Shall have
 a half a Dozen of fowls and privilage to keep them on the premises

She shall have her Bed and Board and the best one Table seats and
panes She shall have the one half of my garden and a patch for beds
they shall sow a Quarter of an acre with flax for his yearly where the
sow their own the shall find and procure one hundred and forty
Pound of pecke and Ten Bushels of Orie and five bushels of
wheat for his yearly they shall find and procure his Needfull fire
wood she shall have Liberty to the orchard to give as many apples
or other fruit as she will have need for for his own house and in case
the apples are plenty the shall allow a couple a Barrells of peder to his
yearly all the above mentioned she shall have During his natural
Life and after she Departs this Life it shall all fall to my Estate
again and shall be equally Divided amongst them as I shall
hereafter mention as my personal Estate is my will that it shall
be sold by public vendue shortly after my Decease and my lands
I do value and appraise to the Sum of Five hundred and fifty pounds
in case that either of my Two Sons Jonathan or Michael Fiedla
would be so minded to buy it at my appraisement and pay them
my hereafter mentioned their proportionable part as hereinafter mentioned
