proceeded to discharge the duties required of us by said order
and I beg leave to state that we went upon the land of
which Peyton A. Hail died seized and after looking into
consideration quality and quantity proceeded to lay off
to Rosamund A. widow of the said Peyton A. Hail and
her dower in the land by beginning at the end of a
cross fence in Levi Perkins line and running with said
fence a strait line to a bend in Elk Creek near the
stone house thence up and binding on the creek
to the prime fork in said creek thence leaving the creek
and running with and binding on the Blue Spring gap
road to the East corner of a lot of land known as corner
at Sevenpoints lot thence with the line of said lot
to the line of a tract of land of William Rudy thence
with the line of the said tract to Levi Perkins line
and with the same to the beginning containing by
estimate one hundred and fifty we also assigned to
the said Rosamund A. Hail all the interests belonging
to the said Peyton A. Hail in the first and second mills
