herein made, doth recollect his Testament in manner
and forme following. That is to say I desire that
all my Chattels & effects, and furniture & household
effects after the payment of my just debts and funeral
expenses, I leave to my wife Anne Corbett a Comfort
able servant to be preserved for her use and expenses
as they think best during the term of her natural life
and after her decease what is left to be equally
divided with my children and to be my executors
forever & by & I desire that the land that I have got
and needed to my wife that they shall hold it and all
other things that I have given or may give to my
sons and daughters for them to hold them same in
posse for ever & as for my house and lot my
executors to save them labor they think best and
my wish is for Mr Rhudy to give up the spring
and spring house that I own and for me to make
quantity of land to make it convenient to my lot
and make his title to it and let them be sold to

gather is my desire if he will not consent with this
that he shall be left out with five dollars & his desires that
his two Brothers part be divided between his children Anna
Jane & Elancy or their children but if one of them dies before
the other without a child, or children the survivor is to have
their Mothers share, if both are with out a child or children then
their Mothers share, to be divided Between my other children or
their heirs and lastly I do hereby appoint my son Levi Bonett
and Alexander Bennett Executors of this my last will and
testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal January the 24th 1859.
